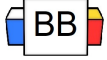

What are disjunctive conjunctions?

Conjunctions which present two alternatives are called disjunctive or alternative conjunctions.

Examples:

- Or
- Either...or
- Neither...nor
- Neither
- Nor
- Otherwise

Example: My platypus will change plans at the last second or just lie to me.

Example: Either he is lying, or you are lying.

Example: Neither my cat nor my platypus enjoy water.

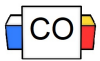
